

Teachers quite sociable
 ↳ friendships/quality → good teamwork
 ↳ will comment on this again after formal and informal meetings
 business-casual dress code among teachers, none for students
 [IT's classroom]

↳ routines for certain groups (eg. grade 3s have point system in place)
 ↳ students bring attendance sheets to the office first period and after lunch

↳ done by teacher silently
 ↳ I'm supposed to do attendance during stage, but not sure I could do it silently — but change is also 1st time with students, thus routines do it the court
 ↳ will see what I can do
 ↳ grades 1 & 2 do the calendar
 ↳ month, year, days of the week, counting

English use — most of the time for 3rd so far (have not seen 4th-6th yet) more French (though still majority English) with 1st & 2nd
 ↳ older students encouraged to use English, however I think encouragement depends on student level
 ↳ responses in French are generally accepted
 ↳ students either walk with their teachers or off to French classroom downstairs

↳ two lines, quiet and straight
 ↳ students are able to talk amongst themselves, though using English is encouraged
 ↳ younger students: often shout out, but quietest is called Cupid — student usually gets the hint afterwards.
 ↳ focus remains on teacher, students make contributions

↳ activities are student-centred but guidance is often provided
 ↳ NOTE: these are younger students right now, could be different ones
